The PVMH Symposium is *unique* in that:

- #1 It is an *immersive experience* for Veterans and Servicemembers with various care providers from the healthcare systems and community resources who serve them.
- #2 Everyone benefits when we bring Veterans and Servicemembers together with providers of traditional medicine as well as community service organizations that are dedicated to Veteran and Servicemembers' health and wellness.
- #3 Veterans and Servicemembers *have a voice* in this learning environment for providers, educators, and researchers!

This two-day event features nationally known keynote speakers, health expert panels with audience Q&A, and evidence-driven presentations on topics such as suicide prevention, traumatic brain injury, sexual assault, and toxic exposures. Participants present research, policies, and experiences with cutting edge medical treatments and innovative alternative therapies like creative arts and outdoor therapy. Optional post-conference workshops provide more individualized experiences to learn about how Veterans and Servicemembers can use creative expression to process service-related trauma.

HIGHLIGHTING SHARED HUMAN EXPERIENCE, RESILIENCE AND HOPE

Modern Warrior LIVE is a theatrical touring production and virtual program that uses immersive music and powerful narratives to catalyze meaningful conversation about mental health and post-traumatic growth. Narrated by cocreator Staff Sergeant Jaymes Poling, who spent three years in Afghanistan as an infantryman with the 82nd Airborne Division, this autobiographical production details Poling's time in the military and his subsequent transition back home.

Through a tapestry of Jaymes' story, as well as performances led by **Modern Warrior LIVE** cocreator Dominick Farinacci and a cast of worldclass artists in multiple genres, the production shares a personal and emotional journey of the challenges of military service and the hurdles veterans face when transitioning back home.

This performance leads to a heightened awareness of the psychological weight of war, as well as the challenges faced post war, and the potential for positive growth. Modern Warrior Live is a thought-provoking and empowering production that brings together a compelling story of personal growth with dynamic musical performances. The show has been presented over 120 times across theaters, mental health conferences, high schools, trauma centers and veteran organizations throughout the country. Modern Warrior LIVE has recently been featured on national broadcasts of Fox and Friends and NPR's Here and Now.

THE MISSION of Modern Warrior LIVE is to break down the societal barriers that leave veterans feeling alone. It is a catalyst for meaningful conversation about mental health, post-traumatic growth, and the veteran experience.

In 2020, **Modern Warrior LIVE** received a grant from the National Endowment for the Arts to produce a film version of the performance. To create the film, the show was recorded 12 times – with each individual taking the stage alone due to COVID. The film has allowed **Modern Warrior LIVE** to continue reaching audiences virtually during the pandemic.

Jaymes Poling grew up in Warren, Ohio and enlisted in the US Army at the age of 17. He was assigned to the 82nd Airborne Division in Fort Bragg, North Carolina as an infantryman. During his eight years with the division, he spent 3 years fighting in Afghanistan as a Machine Gunner and Squad Leader.

Dealing with the memories of war, the loss of friends, and the isolation a combat veteran finds when leaving the military, Jaymes began to find the potential for growth that comes through adversity. Through education, writing, and public speaking, he came to recognize the universality of his journey.

Jaymes received a finance degree at John Carroll University in May 2018, and focuses his time traveling across the country partnering with veteran organizations to help veterans find their own peace after war.

Dominick Farinacci is a world renowned trumpeter with a passion for performing and for integrating the arts into wellness and education. He has released 12 albums, performed in more than 120 cities around the world and received foundation grants to establish arts programs in his native Ohio.

He served as Ambassador to Jazz at Lincoln Center in Qatar 2013-2015, working to further integrate music and arts into wellness and education. He organized the very first jazz performance for patients in Abu Dhabi in collaboration with the Cleveland Clinic and the Abu Dhabi Music and Arts Foundation.

Before developing Modern Warrior LIVE, Dominick was a frequent speaker on the connection between mental health and music, including doing a TED Talk in 2014 at the Kennedy Center.

Our team of writers and artists work with each veteran to help them put voice to their challenges, fears, frustrations and hopes. The Modern Warrior Experience workshops culminate in a live performance where the participants take the stage with our artists, shaping the show as they want and need it to be for a small and personally invited audience.
