This course focuses on community-oriented and population-focused nursing practice. Using evidence-based practice and public health concepts, students assess, plan, implement, and evaluate health interventions to individuals, families, and populations. Clinical experiences give students the opportunity to develop new knowledge through the application and synthesis of community/public health concepts, use of community resources and exposure to nursing roles. Students will assess health needs of a target population and use evidence-based resources to develop, implement, and evaluate an intervention that addresses an indentified population-focused health concern.
