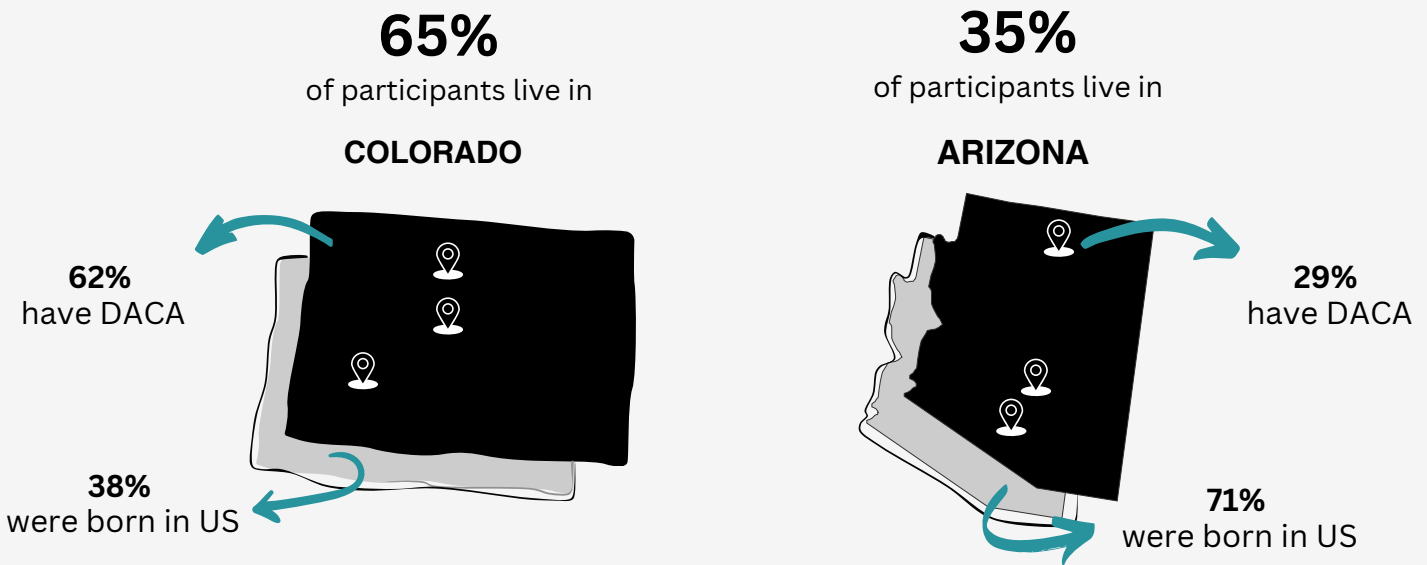

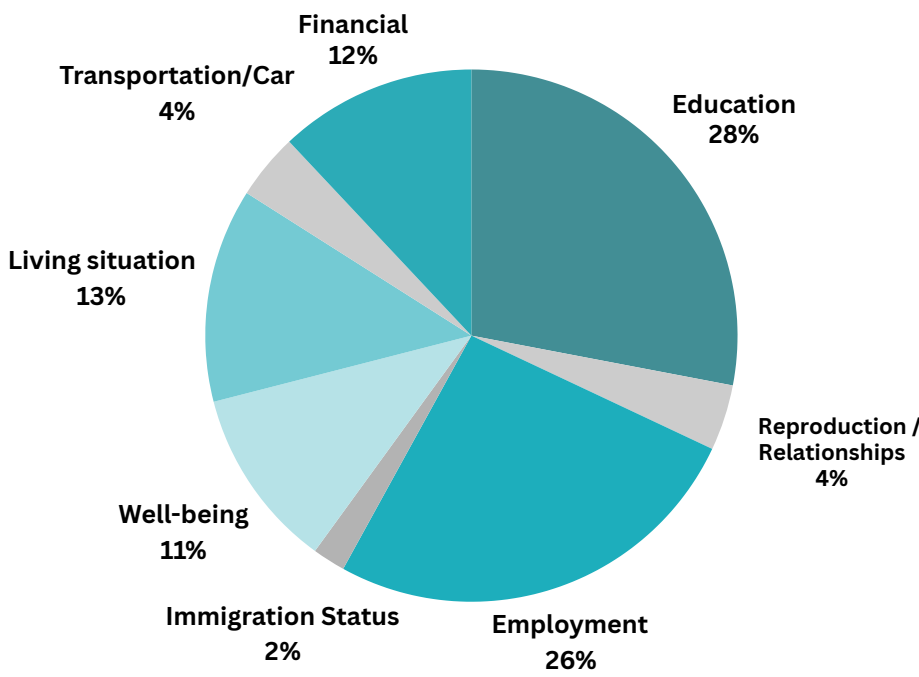
Participants' location when they joined the study:

Total participants = 40



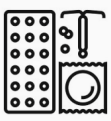
Preliminary results of weekly surveys thorough November 2024

Goals reported by participants.



The most commonly reported goals are related to **education, employment, financial and living situation.**

Well-being



48% are not using their preferred **birth control**

Reasons for not using it: Cost, difficulty getting an appointment, not having sex frequently, concerns about side effects, insertion, or removal, not having enough information, and provider discouragement.

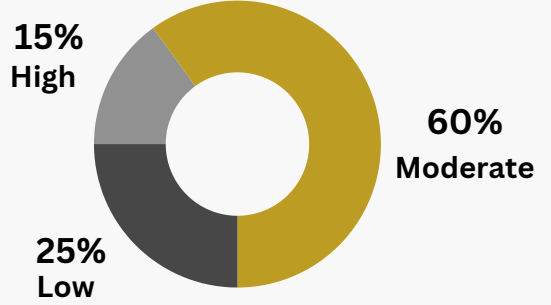


20% reported changes in **physical health.**



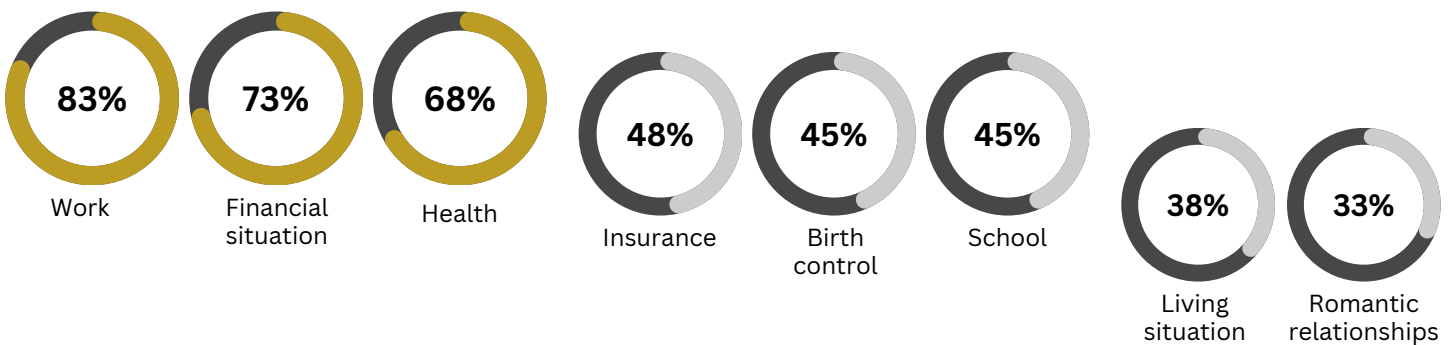
35% reported changes in **mental health.**

At the beginning of the study **75%** reported moderate or high **stress.**



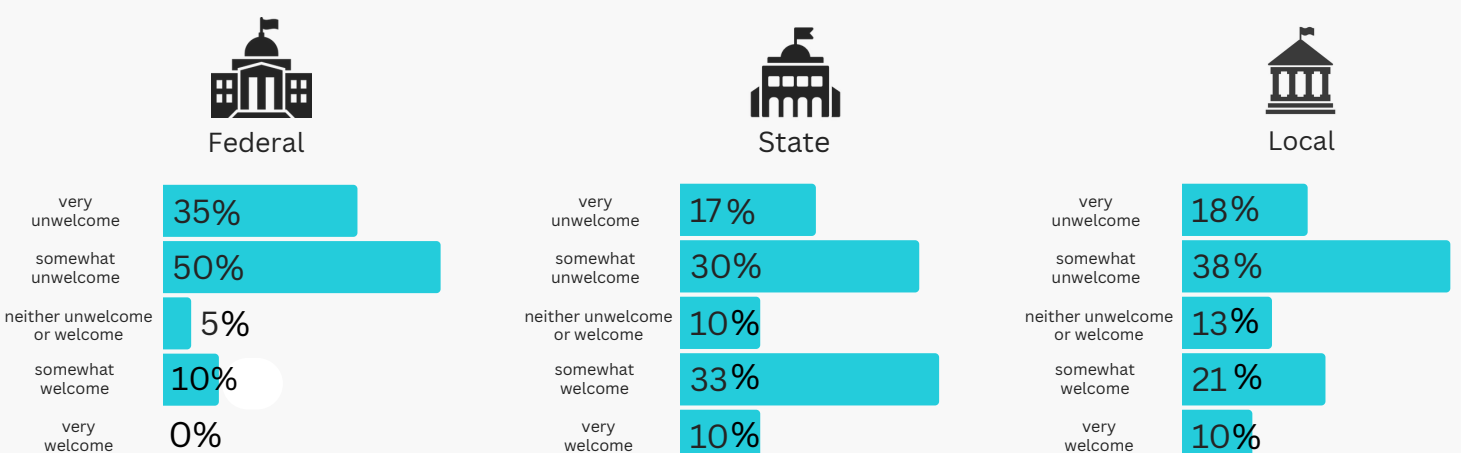
Life changes
